- Perform microcircuits assembly requiring fine hand assembly, manually aligns parts, using IPC soldering standards.
- Verify correct part placement, performs microscope inspection.
- Operate automatic and semi-automatic machines to position, solder and clean prescribed components on printed circuit boards.
- Document in detail the repair work done and components used in repair record.
- Repair and overhaul older devices and replace defective components.
- Willingness to work in a fast pace and team oriented environment.
